What would you give birth to each day as a divine idea, as a holy thought, as a loving feeling that, when emanated as a fragrance from your heart, would impress itself far and wide as a great blessing to the universe and to life, to those whom you have come to serve? If you can find this special something at the beginning of the day, meditate upon it, and seek to animate this beautiful ideation throughout your hours of service, your meals, your times of reflection and play, or simply in your discussions with others, then each day will become progressively infused with a greater Godbeingness of your heart; which when accumulated over a lifetime results in the completion of your holy mission and the summation of all that you, as a soulful one, have incarnated upon this Earth to complete.

You may conceive of God in whatever way you please. Some see God as a great Father-Mother being of light in the center of the cosmos. Others behold God as pure mind; others as the eternal light that permeates all that is, including self. And the brightness, the glow, the perfection, and the hallowedness of that existence permeate your being and may be expressive within you of the glory of your soul and spirit, your reality, your love.

As we move through life throughout this year—gracefully, joyously, with consciousness, and with respect and reverence toward all—grace coalesces around everything that we involve ourselves in, to the point that we bring this higher awareness into play through what we do. We create many things through our thoughts, our feelings, our actions, our words; and yet these things, because they have been expressed with grace, become part of the eternal nature of all that is, the universe itself. When we do things consciously, that consciousness embeds itself within what we do to give it long life, even everlasting life. As we breathe with the Holy Spirit, that breath becomes an infusion, by grace, of our essence into what we coccreate. And as God looks upon it and says that it is good, it is divine, it is beautiful, it is harmonious, it is pure, then it is stamped with that approval. And in that stamping, it becomes part of the beautiful nature of all that is.
